

AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES ACT (ADA) TRANSITION PERIOD PLAN
PUBLIC MEETING NOTICE AND COMMENT PERIOD

TITLE II of the ADA:

- Prohibits discrimination against individuals with disabilities
- Requires each “service, program, or activity” of a public entity, when viewed in its entirety, to be readily accessible to and usable by individuals with disabilities.
- Requires a public entity to develop a transition plan where structural changes are necessary to achieve program accessibility by:
 - Identifying the various services, programs and activities offered by the City.
 - Identify the locations where such services, programs and activities are available or held.
 - Identify elements in these locations that do not comply with current ADA standards and could prevent a person with a disability from accessing the service, program or event.
 - Create a schedule of improvements for elements identified as not conforming with current ADA standards.
- Requires a public comment period in which the City solicits input from the public for the draft ADA transition plan.

The City of Danville is enacting a policy called the *Danville ADA Transition Plan*. This plan is based on the requirements of the Americans with Disability Act found in the United States Code of Federal Regulations, Title 28, Section 35.150(d). The plan creates a policy for the City of Danville for persons with disabilities.
