A RESOLUTION APPROVING A CONTRACT FOR A HOUSEHOLD ELECTRONIC COLLECTIONS EVENT

WHEREAS, the City of Danville operates the Solid Waste Division of the Public Works Department as an Enterprise Fund for the purpose of collecting and disposing of waste generated by residential units of three or less; and

WHEREAS, certain electronic household waste items may not be placed in the Landfill, thereby creating a need to dispose of them properly; and

WHEREAS, computers, TV's, monitors and other similar items are no longer collected at local recycling companies in the Danville area; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Danville, would like to offer a limited household electronics collection event to allow City Solid Waste customers to dispose of up to six (6) items per household; and

WHEREAS, A Request for Proposals was issued for interested Collection Vendor's, with Proposals received and opened on September 2, 2016; and

WHEREAS, the Proposal determined to be most consistent with City goals and collection costs was submitted by Vintage Tech Recyclers of Plainfield, IL in the amount of \$24,800.00 for the collection of up to 50,000 pounds of approved electronic waste items.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Danville that:

1. The Proposal submitted by Vintage Tech Recyclers for the collection of 50,000 pounds of household electronic items for the amount of \$24,800.00 be approved.
2. The FY 2016-17 Solid Waste Fund budget be amended to increase line item 405-405-52099 Other Contractual Services in the amount of \$24,800.00 to cover costs of this collection event with said funds to come from the Solid Waste Fund Reserve.
3. The Mayor and City Clerk be authorized to execute all contract documents
4. This Resolution shall take effect upon its passage and publication.
