

# **HOUSEHOLD ELECTRONICS RECYCLING EVENT**

**SATURDAY - October 7, 2017 - 8:00 AM to 11:30 AM**

**Hosted at Danville Public Works 1155 E. Voorhees Street**

## **To all City of Danville Solid Waste Collection customers:**

We are happy to offer you an opportunity to unload those old TV's, computers, monitors and other similar household electronic items. The Solid Waste Division of Danville Public Works is sponsoring a collection event for such items. Please join us to properly dispose of those items which are no longer legally permitted in landfills.

Green Wave Computer Recycling will be on site to remove and process the items on the attached list. Each customer/account holder of the City Solid Waste Collection system will be able to drop off up to six (6) items during the collection event. City Solid Waste personnel and staff of Green Wave will be on site to retrieve the items from your vehicle and sort them for processing.

## **The following is a summary of requirements to participate:**

**For all account holders who receive paper billing**, you will need to bring the message stub from your September bill with you to submit at the collection line. The September message refers to the Collection Event. No other month's bill will be accepted, and everyone must have proper documentation as a customer to enter the line. This stub will be taken at the event.

**For all account holders that have direct-debit** from your checking account, you will be mailed a postcard that must be retained and submitted on-site to enter the collection line. This postcard references the event and must be an original document with address. No copies or duplicates will be accepted. The postcard will be taken at the time you enter the drop-off line.

**Tenants of Leased properties must obtain proper documentation from the property owner.**

**For all customers that receive statement billing** due to multiple accounts, your September bill will include a listing of each of your properties. Property owners may then distribute those listings to the appropriate addresses for each account. Those tenants may then bring the strip provided to the collection event for proof of participation in the waste collection program.

This is the second annual electronics collection event and we do anticipate a significant level of interest and participation. Please anticipate long lines and extended waiting periods. All vehicles in line at 11:30 AM will be permitted through the collection lanes. Any vehicles arriving after 11:30 AM will be turned away. Everyone must remain in their vehicle at all times, and follow the directional signage. Collection lanes will have personnel to remove items from your vehicle, and you will then be directed to proceed out through the gate. We ask everyone to be considerate of one another and help make this an enjoyable event for all.

**This event is funded 100% through monthly fees paid to the City of Danville Solid Waste Enterprise Fund. For that reason, only regular customers of the City Waste Collection Program are qualified to participate. We sincerely appreciate your assistance and cooperation in making this a successful event.**
