REDUCED-FARE RIDERS
 Those eligible for JARC or DMT reduced-fare include:
 *Children over 46" through middle school
 *Full-time DACC or high school students with school ID
 *People with disabilities with DMT or CUMTD Photo ID card
 *Veterans with current VA ID card
 *Medicare cardholders with DMT or CUMTD Photo ID

TRANSFERS
 Transfers must be purchased at the time the fare is paid to allow a passenger to make a complete one-way trip. Transfers are not intended to allow a passenger to make a return trip to the point of origin.

Transfers are issued free of charge with a JARC fare. Passengers boarding DMT buses in order to transfer to JARC service to Champaign should pay the JARC fare when initially boarding. Passengers boarding CUMTD buses in order to transfer to JARC service to Danville should pay the CUMTD fare and obtain a transfer which will allow \$1.00 / \$0.50 credit toward the JARC cash fare to Danville.
